

Materials List for Gouache Plein Air Painting

Required Colors:

- permanent white (get bigger tubes)
- burnt sienna
- burnt umber
- yellow ochre
- cadmium yellow
- cadmium red
- alizarine red
- ultramarine
- sky blue
- viridian
- linden green
- brilliant green

*** I like Windsor and Newton Designer Gouache**

—**Masterson STA WET HANDY palette** (<http://www.dickblick.com/products/masterson-sta-wet-handly-palette/>)- **keeps paints moist, and very portable**

OR

really any surface to put your paints on (small watercolor palette works too)

— **1 1/2 inch synthetic water color FLAT brush, 1 inch brush, one round brush** (I like brands like Windsor and Newton Cotman or Da Vinci)

—**Cottonwood Arts 5x7 Laminated Coldpress block (10 sheets)**

OR

—**Aquarelle Coldpress -watercolor block 300g/m2- 140 lb 10x14in** (<http://www.dickblick.com/products/arches-watercolor-blocks/>)

—**Sketching pencil or sketching pen (ball point pen)**

—**Artist Tape-** (I like about 1/4 inch thick) great for blocking out clean edges on paper for doing thumbnail studies

—**plastic cup for water** (I like Faber Castell water holder where they can shrink and expand (Blick has them) but cut water bottles or small glass container with lid works too)

—**paper towels!!!**

—**small spray Bottle-** to spray on your paints- they will get dry sometimes when painting in heat!
